- Mentor an adult student
- Adhere to P.A.L.S. – Project Adult Literacy Society Policies
- Communicate with the Program Coordinator on a regular basis regarding student's progress and/or concerns
- Complete reports and outcomes as requested
- Volunteer tutors can determine when a match needs to be ended in consultation with the Program Coordinator

Responsibilities to Student:

- Meet with student on a weekly basis
- Maintain confidentiality of the match
- Build on the skills of the student and help them meet their goals
- Recognize and acknowledge the student's learning progress
